Accident Policy

Parents/carers/guardians are asked to sign an accident book if injuries occur whilst riding or participating in any other activity with Gateway Wheelers.

Also if a rider should come to Gateway Wheelers with an injury of any kind the parent/carer/guardian will be asked to sign the book on reporting it to the club leader volunteer.

If a rider has an accident whilst at Gateway Wheelers the situation will be assessed by the club leader and if necessary the rider will be taken to see a doctor immediately and the parents/carers/guardian will be contacted immediately.

At each ride we will have at least one qualified first aider.

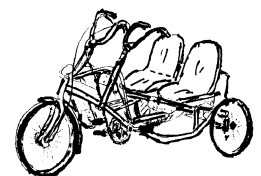
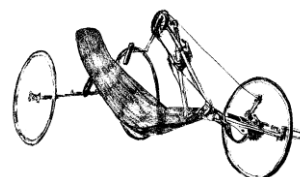
In the event of an accident Gateway Wheelers volunteers will:

- Deal with any minor accidents
- Write all information, including names of witness(es), in the accident book.
- Get parents/carers/guardians, on picking up the rider, to sign the accident book and read the information regarding the incident.

If staff see evidence of injury on a rider, which has not occurred whilst at Gateway Wheelers and hasn't been reported to any member of staff, parents will be asked for information on the incident and instructed to write it in the back of the accident book.
