#### Use of Resources and Materials:

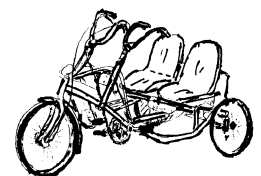
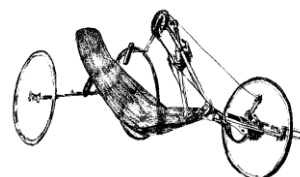
Wherever possible we will:

- Maintain gardens/lawns or other external areas with concern for the enhancement, protection and preservation of bio-diversity in the area

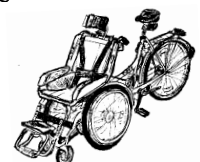
#### Waste and Recycling:

### Travel:

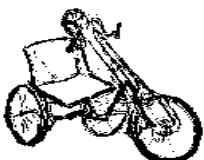
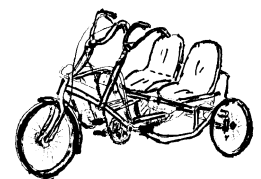
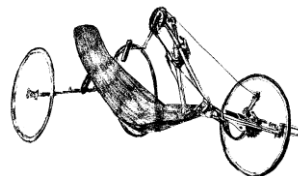
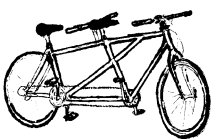
Wherever possible we will:
