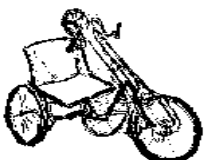
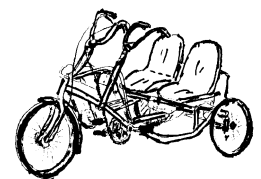
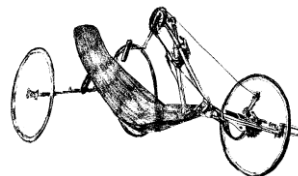
Equal Opportunities Policy
